

Registration

If you are for the first time accessing the DID-ACT moodle, you have to options to create an account.

(1) If you have an email address with a university or academic institution, you can click on "Shibboleth Login" and then select your institution and click on "ok". You are then redirected to your institutional login page, where you enter your credentials. Finally, you are redirected to the DID-ACT moodle and can access all courses.

(2) If you do not have an institutional email address, do not want to use it, or the Shibboleth access described above does not work you can also create an account. Click on "Create new account" and you are redirected to a form where you can choose a username and password and enter some personal details and then click on "Create new account". A confirmation email will be sent to your email address including a link with which you can complete your registration.


